### Conference Materials

Short summaries of all works presented during the conference will be published in the Book of Abstracts.

The summary (1 page abstract) of the paper should be submitted till the end of April. The criteria for acceptance of the papers are as follows:

- Papers must not be previously published.
- Papers will be selected on the basis of relevance and significance to commodity science.
- Papers must relate to the Conference theme.
- Papers must be based on scientific research and contain primarily new information.

Papers prepared following the enclosed instructions should be sent to the Organizing Committee of the Conference by 31<sup>st</sup> May. The papers submitted after this date will not be accepted.

Selected submitted papers will be published after peer review in the Research Papers edited by Poznań University of Economics (Zeszyty Naukowe UEP, 9 points in Polish classification). The publication cost of one conference paper is included in the registration fee but the next ones must be paid extra.

The total length of the paper is 8-12 pages.
