

Teaching with the IESEG INTERNATIONAL SUMMER ACADEMY July 1 - 30, 2012, PARIS

The **IESEG International Summer Academy** invites faculty from partner universities to teach in July 2012.

The **IESEG International Summer Academy 2012** will take place from 1 – 30 July at our Paris Campus (Grande Arche – La Defense). The IESEG International Summer Academy is a 4 weeks intense program for college and university juniors and recent graduates. The focus of the programme is International Business and Management for students coming from all disciplines.

Students earn ECTS credits through active participation and an assessment at the end of each week or during the week. Each class size is maximum 25 students and all courses are taught in English.

In July 2011 around 100 students from 23 different nationalities participated in this programme and have greatly enjoyed learning in the IESEG multicultural environment.

You are invited to teach during one of the following weeks of July 2012: the week of July 9th, 16th or 23d.

The course is a 16 contact hour unit for 2 ECTS credits. One contact hour contains 45 minutes. The course is scheduled as followed:

Conditions:

Stipend: IESEG pays 85 € net per contact hour (16 contact hours x 85 = 1360 €).

In addition, IESEG offers you to cover 700 € for housing and other expenses (proof of payment is required), covers your travel expenses to Paris and back (economy class round trip ticket), and provides office support (prints course material).

There is a small hospitality package including museum pass, welcome lunch and networking event.
